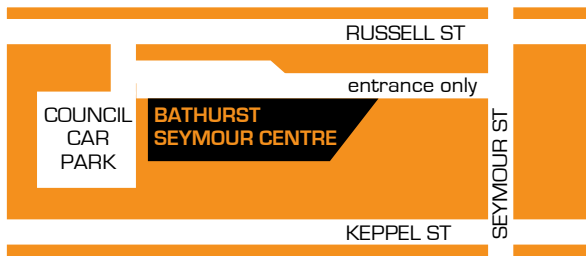


# What do we provide?
